A value of .5 indicates that local marijuana arrests are one half the percentage they represent of all national arrests.

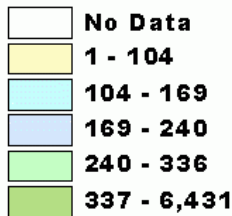
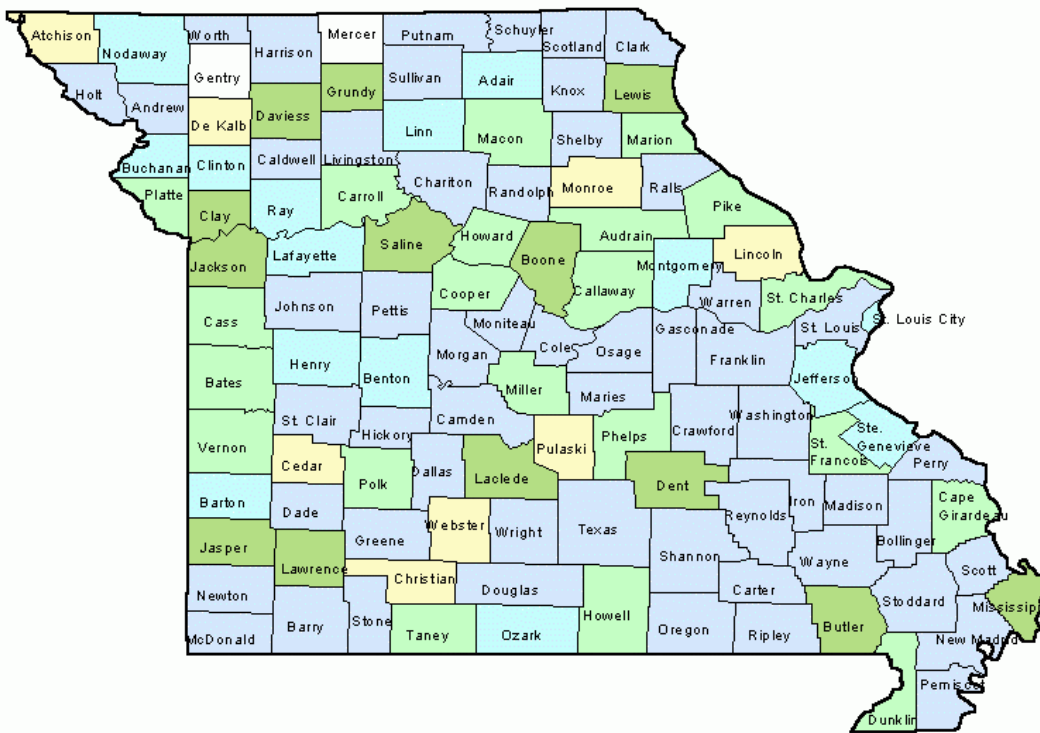
